The training can be accessed at https://ethicswebinar.dls.virginia.gov Each module is specific to your role so select "Local elected officials or EDAs/IDAs" to complete the correct training. Please remember there is no completion certificate for this training, so my suggestion is to take a screenshot of your completion message. Let both your SWCD administrative staff and your local jurisdiction's clerk know your completion date.
- Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Training for Directors: The Code of VA requires locally elected officials to take the FOIA training once every two years based on the date of completion of the last training session. The VA Freedom of Information Act Advisory Council has several options available for fulfilling the FOIA training requirement. It is recommended that you take a screen shot of the completion message once you finish the training. Please visit https://foiacouncil.dls.virginia.gov/training.htm to access these options. This is an off year for most directors but check your dates with SWCD Admin staff.
 - Click on the link (above) and scroll down to the heading "Other Courses" and then to the sub heading titled "Local Officials Course". In this section, there should be a big blue box that says "Register". Use this box to register for one of the four upcoming webinar courses listed below.

- Cost Share approvals required by June 15th per the VSWCB Policy (see language below) and the state budget Appropriations language. During the 2025 General Assembly Session, a budget amendment authorized the reallocation of unobligated cost-share funds by the Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board from the Chesapeake Bay watershed to areas outside of the Chesapeake Bay watershed (Southern Rivers). That budget amendment requires Districts to obligate cost-share funding by June 15 of each year. Both the FY2026 Cost-Share and Technical Assistance Funding Policy and the FY2026 Cost-Share and Technical Assistance Grant Agreement reflect the June 15 deadline for District Board actions to obligate cost-share funds. What does this mean to your district? There can be no approvals beyond June 15th so plan accordingly. I might suggest you look toward May as being the last board meeting to approve new BMP contracts and use June to close out projects and clean up loose ends before the Fiscal year ends June 30.

Excerpt from policy: 9. Reallocation of Cost-Share: Following the end of each fiscal year, the Board shall reallocate (redistribute) unobligated VACS allocations, including unobligated funds from prior fiscal years, and unobligated CREP or RCPP funds (keeping cost-share within the drainage basin it was originally allocated within). These funds will be used for VACS programmatic priorities which may include funding for Chesapeake Bay Watershed Implementation Plan or targeted agricultural BMPs. VACS funds that have not been approved by the District's Board of Directors by June 15, 2026, to fund an existing cost-share application are considered to be unobligated and must be returned to the Department.

- <u>VA Tax Credit Reminder:</u> The 'Technical Certification Date' and the 'Tax Credit Certification Signature Date' must be within the same calendar year for the tax credit to be valid. Some District Boards do not meet in December so if you anticipate projects being completed late in the year that will need tax credit approval, your Board may want to give delegated authority to an available Director to handle tax credit approvals and signatures through the end of the year. If a producer requests tax credit that will not be approved until a January Board meeting the 'Technical Certification Date' and 'Tax Credit Certification Signature Date' will both need to be in 2026, and the tax credit will not be eligible for redemption until 2026 taxes are filed. The recording of the Tax Credit training session held 11/8/24 is available in CAS on the Forms page.
- <u>CCI Enrollment or Re-enrollment</u>: This is the time of year to be preparing and approving any CCI eligible BMPs or existing CCI practices coming out of lifespan on December 31, 2025. Taking signup and certifying the new CCI practice before the end of this calendar year will allow the new lifespan to start immediately on January 1, 2026, as soon as the current lifespan ends. In CAS it is

- critical that the 'Technical Certification Date' on the General tab reflect technical certification by the end of this calendar year to avoid a break in lifespan.
- Remember to use the Related Instances function in CAS when a CCI practices follows an expired VACS BMP. More credit is given for a CCI linked to a functioning VACS BMP vs. a standalone CCI BMP.
- IT Security Training: deadline December 15, 2025, for all users of Conservation Application Suite. To access the training https://training.knowbe4.com/ui/users/login. Users received an email from Carl Thiel-Goin with instructions on 10/28 with log in details. Follow these instructions carefully. If you began employment with the District in calendar year 2025 and took the training, you are exempt from taking it again in 2025.
- <u>Update to VACS Definition of Applicant:</u> The Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board met on September 16 and approved a mid-year amendment to the VACS Manual to revise the definition of 'applicant'. In the Guidelines and Glossary sections of the manual, the definition of 'applicant' now includes the following: "Any individual, landowner, agent, operator of record, or business entity who is determined to have knowingly misrepresented its compliance status with the VACS Program to a District or District Representative may, upon a determination of a Board of District Directors, not be considered an "applicant" for a period of at least five (5) years. In rendering such a determination, the Board of District Directors shall evaluate all available evidence in a public meeting, and any related resolutions must be passed by a majority vote of a quorum of District Directors."

Associate Director Job Descriptions and Guidelines: DCR has received questions recently about the roles, responsibilities, and ability for Associate Directors to participate in SWCD meetings. Each District Board is requested to review and revise as needed their current Associate Director Job Description and policy or guidelines.

- o Associate Directors of VA SWCDs are not referenced in Code of VA.
- o No official decision from OAG exists on what Associate Directors can and can't do.
- OAG guidance is that all <u>SWCDs should create and adopt an Associate Director Job Description</u>. The purpose of this job description is to define clear parameters as to what Associate Directors are authorized by the local BOD to do. Without such parameters in place, it could be argued in court that all Associate Directors have all voting rights, which is clearly not the intent of an elected board nor the intention of anyone when Associate Director positions were initially created. This includes covering when an Associate Director can and cannot vote.

DCR recommends districts adopt associate director's job guidelines including the following components:

- o Purpose of Associate Director
- O Associate Directors may be members of committees established by the board and they have voting rights on said committees.
- Associate Directors may be Chairs of committees established by local BODs.
- o An Associate Director who is Chair of a committee may present committee recommendations to the BOD at a regular or special-called board meeting for consideration; however, an Associate Director may not vote in such meetings.
- An Associate Director may not make a stand-alone motion in a regular or special-called board meeting.
- Associate Directors may participate in discussions in board meetings, but they do not have voting rights.
- o Associate Directors may be invited to participate in closed meetings.

<u>DCR Director Matthew Wells</u> returned to the private sector November 1, 2025, after four years of service to DCR. Upon his departure, Chief Deputy Director Andrew Smith will serve as Acting Director of DCR.

VA. Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ)

DEQ's Valley Regional Office (VRO) staff completed the nuisance algae monitoring season (May 2025-October 2025) last month. Starting in May, the VRO Team visited six sites monthly, four on the North Fork Shenandoah River and two on the South Fork Shenandoah River, to collect observations of algae substrate coverage. When growth was above 10% coverage of a transect, a sample was collected for laboratory analysis. Three of the monthly monitoring sites did not have enough prolific algae growth to collect a sample until October. The other three sites were visited monthly, but no samples were collected this monitoring season due to low algae growth. A total of four algae complaints were received by VRO; two samples were collected in response to these complaints.
